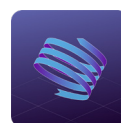

Tips

- Ask what components are part of the core system and what add-on modules are available.
- Ask about implementation requirements for each component so you understand the time commitment to achieve the results you are seeking.
- Be ready to devote the necessary time to implement, learn, understand, and use your software. Software is powerful, but you must commit time to achieve the best results. If a team is necessary, establish component or process champions as subject matter experts, continuously learning and improving the product.

Tips

- If multi-site is a needed feature, be sure to ask if this is part of the core system or an add-on feature.
- Ask to see a demonstration of how different product types are handled in the system.
- Ask vendors who they integrate their products with and understand the level of functionality.
- Does the system provide a single source of truth for shipping and is that information communicated back into the print MIS to automatically update job and customer records?

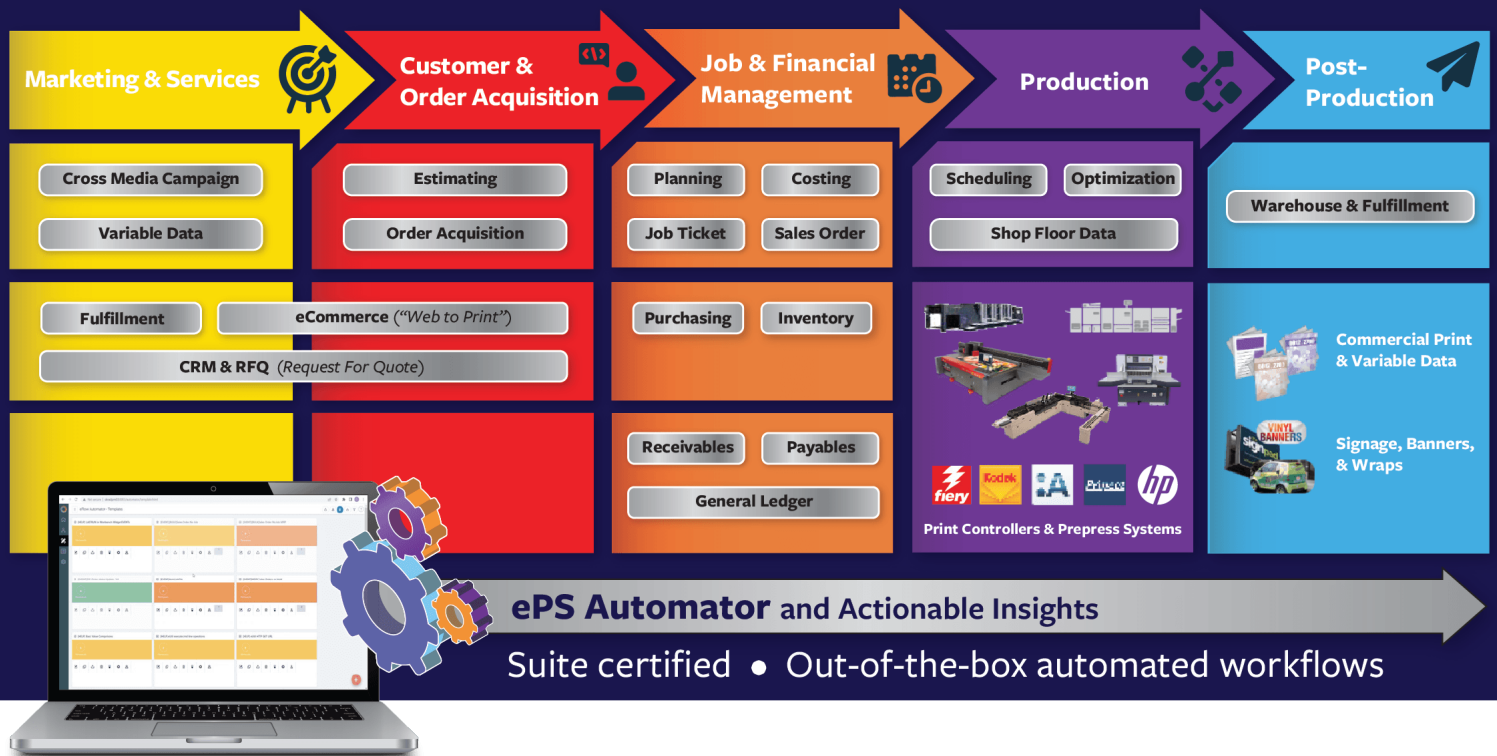
